(Teams, Schedules, Standings)

Welcome to the Pacific Coast Spring Soccer League (PCSSL). This is our 18th year and we are looking forward to another successful season. Please read the following information carefully and return the requested forms along with your check for \$150.00. **The fee will be \$250.00 if received after 10:00 PM on 1/27/2017. No registration accepted after 10:00 PM on 2/10/2017.** Any forms not completed properly will not be processed and will be returned to you.

When:	All games will be played on SUNDAYS . Games will begin on March 5, 2017 and will continue through May 21, 2017. Each division will play eight games (possibly fewer in U16/U19) and there are no playoffs. All games must be completed by May 31, 2017, if weather related make-up games are required.
Who:	Any AYSO team with players properly registered in their home region is invited to participate. All players must play at least one-half of each game they attend.
Age Groups	Boys & Girls Under-10, Under-12, Under-14, Under-16 and Under-19
Roster Sizes & # of players on the play field:	Under-10 - 7 v 7 (12 players on the roster maximum) Under-12 - 9 v 9 (14 players on the roster maximum) Under-14 - 11 v 11 (18 players on the roster maximum) Under-16 and Under-19 - 11 v 11 (20 players on the roster maximum) Coed teams are allowed, however they must play in the boys divisions only
Coaches:	All coaches must meet the following requirements: Properly registered in AYSO for MY2016, AYSO Safe Haven certified, CDC Concussion Awareness Trained and certified at or above the level of their team: Under-10: AYSO U-10 Coach certification , Under-12: U-12 Coach , Under-14: Intermediate Coach , and Under-16 and Under-19: Advanced Coach . All coaches will be required to attend the mandatory coaches meeting in mid-February, 2017 (date and location to be provided). A (1) one-point deduction in standings will occur for non-attendance of any mandatory meetings.
Referees:	Referees will be of the highest caliber. Minimum expected badge level – Referees: U10-Regional, U12-Regional (Intermediate preferred), U14-Intermediate (Advanced preferred), U16 & U19-Advanced (National preferred) . Assistant Referees: U10, U12 and U14-Regional, U16 and U19-Intermediate . For U14-U19, this includes referees actively in the process of upgrading to the target badge level. Procurement of referees is the responsibility of the home team's region. <u>All matches must have one referee to be official and having two assistant referees is strongly encouraged</u>
Fields:	Fields, nets and corner flags are the responsibility of the home team or the home team's region. Each team should secure a field for home games.
Fees:	\$150.00 (\$250.00 if received by the league after 10:00 PM Friday, 1/27/2017). Checks need to be made out to the " <u>American Youth Soccer Organization</u> ".
Registration:	All teams must provide all of the contact information asked for in this packet including Fields and Referee Administrators and the application must be signed by the coach. Send the completed packet and your check made out to the "American Youth Soccer Organization" for 150.00 to the league no later than <u>Friday, January 27, 2017 at 10:00 PM. After that date the fee is \$250.00 per team until February 10, 2017 at 10:00 PM. Beyond that date, NO teams will be accepted.</u> Please do not send eAYSO rosters with your application packet (see below for when they are required).
Player Passes, Coach Passes and eAYSO Rosters:	All players and coaches are required to have a PCSSL stickered laminated AYSO player pass that includes a photo of the player/coach. AYSO teams may obtain player passes from their 2016 fall region team or create new passes. Completed passes must be submitted to your designated PCSSL/AYSO Area registrar no later than ten (10) days prior to the mandatory coaches meeting and must be accompanied with an eAYSO Roster signed by the Regional Commissioner. There is no distinction between head coach and assistant coach in terms of credentials.
Game Day Requirements:	Coaches must possess AYSO player registration (medical release) forms with original ink signatures or e-signature for all players. All players and coaches are required to have a PCSSL stamped laminated AYSO player pass that includes a photo of the player/coach.
Scores:	All scores must be reported within 24 hours on www.mysoccerleague.com , by both teams.

PCSSL Application – Team Availability Dates

Unless checked, our team is available to play PCSSL games on every Sunday from March 5th through May 21st. Please check ALL Sunday's that your team is NOT available. Our team understands that if we are not available for at least 9 Sundays to fit in our 8 games, that at the discretion of the PCSSL Game Scheduler, our team may be required to play two games on any given Sunday.

Please check your team's Spring Break plans and do not commit to playing on a date when you intend to apply to participate in a tournament. Reschedule requests are not possible or practical for many teams and would result in a forfeit loss. In addition, at the league's discretion, failure to field a team would result in being eliminated from award (1st and 2nd place) consideration.

Under-12 – minimum: 70 x 45 yards; maximum: 90 x 55 yards

Under-14 and above – minimum: 95 x 50; maximum: 120 x 75 yards

All Head Coaches Agree to the Following -

1. Have read the league rules posted at www.pcssl.org
2. Will finalize available game dates by February 15th
3. Will play all scheduled games including games that require travel
4. Will check with opposing coach 48 to 72 hours prior to games to confirm the game and all field policies
5. Will enter game results in www.mysoccerleague.com within 24 hours after your games
6. Will assess your team’s level to the best of your ability

PCSSL Scores, Standings and Suspension Information

ALL SCORES must be recorded on the “MySoccerLeague” (www.mysoccerleague.com) Web Site within 24 to 48 hours of your game. Scores not reported within 48 hours will result in a forfeit. All forfeits and rainouts must be reported.

HOME TEAM COACH or **MANAGER** is required to contact the visiting team coach or manager 48 to 72 hours prior to your game to let the visiting team know of any specific field rules that are in place and to iron out any uniform color conflicts (home team must change colors or don pinnies in the event of a conflict)

Game Cards (Under-10, Under-12 and Under-14 games) and **Timesheets** (Under-16 and Under-19 games) are no longer mailed so coaches do not need to provide a stamped envelope. The Center Referee will retain all Game Cards and Timesheets in the event league administrators need to access them. For Under-16 and Under-19 games, Timesheets must be signed by the coach at the conclusion of play and any contested playing time must be documented prior to departing the field.

PLAYER or COACH EJECTION: If a player or coach is ejected, their player pass will be retained by the Center Referee and along with a properly completed referee report, mailed to:

Coaches will need to contact the PCSSL League Director at ayso45drew@gmail.com to make arrangements to pick up a suspended player or coaches’ PCSSL pass. An ejected player must serve a minimum one (1) game suspension and additional suspension time may be dictated at the discretion of league administrators. League administrators reserve the right to contact spring tournaments to honor PCSSL suspensions and PCSSL will honor all suspensions reported by spring tournaments.
